1. Our Graduation Ceremony is **Wednesday, June 8th, Boswell Hall** on the North Idaho Campus. There will be a MANDATORY rehearsal that same day at 11 a.m., same place. You must be at the site no later than 5:30 that night. Doors open to the public at 6 p.m., the actual Ceremony begins at 6:30 sharp and usually lasts about 45 minutes to an hour.
